1. Purpose. To publish functions of TRITRAFAC Bangor under the mission established by reference (a).

2. Cancellation. CNTECHTRAINST 5450.109

3. Mission. To train officer and enlisted personnel in the basic knowledge and skills required to build competence and proficiency in operating and maintaining the TRIDENT submarine and all associated systems; to provide replacement, conversion, advanced, officer, off-crew, and team training to TRIDENT submarine crew members and submarine support personnel in order to increase and maintain knowledge and proficiency in specific skills; and to provide specialized training and perform other such functions and tasks as may be assigned by higher authority.

4. Status and Command Relationships. TRITRAFAC Bangor is a shore activity in an active, fully operational status.

(1) Area Coordinator - Commander in Chief, U.S. Pacific Fleet



5. Overseas Diplomacy. TRITRAFAC Bangor serves as an effective instrument of the U.S. foreign policy by initiating and conducting action programs which promote positive relations between the command and foreign nationals, and which assist

individual naval personnel and their families to work effectively, live with dignity and satisfaction, and function as positive representatives of the Navy and of the United States while overseas.

6. Action. In accomplishing the assigned mission, TRITRAFAC Bangor will ensure performance of the functions in enclosure (1) and advise CNET of any recommended modification to the mission or functions of TRITRAFAC Bangor.

## FUNCTIONS OF TRITRAFAC BANGOR

1. Carry out all regulations and directives from higher authority pertaining to the administration of TRITRAFAC Bangor. Issue such detailed internal directives as are required for the efficient organization and administration of the command
2. Ensure that training courses developed or revised by the command are in consonance with the instructional systems development procedures established by higher authority. Ensure that the training of all personnel enrolled in the schools and courses established by CNET at this command is conducted in accordance with directives and procedures established by higher authority.
3. In support of Navy policy emphasizing the importance of military and motivational training and in recognition of the effect such training has on retention, upgrading professionalism, and improving the perception of the Navy, ensure that the military and motivational aspects of training are given strong emphasis equal to the emphasis afforded the technical areas.
4. Ensure successful and uniform accomplishment of training in accordance with prescribed course material on a standardized basis and ensure high standards of qualification in instructors and students. In furtherance of these objectives, carry out on a continuing basis an evaluation of instruction and the complete learning environment.
5. Maintain and operate the required training equipment, devices, and aids.
6. Provide effective material support of operational and maintenance requirements. This support includes, but is not limited to, procurement, receipt, stowage, issue, and accounting for consumables, equipage, and repair parts.
7. Conduct periodic review of contractor prepared curricula and other training material when directed by higher authority.
8. Make recommendations to CNET regarding the design and development of new course material and any necessary changes to the course material presently being utilized.
9. Participate in the Life Cycle Support Program for TRIDENT training including fulfilling all requirements as the lead school for selected curricula in accordance with directions from higher authority.

10. Conduct, as directed, COMSUBPAC and CNO-controlled courses of instruction.

11. Evaluate on a continuing basis, the requirements for berthing and training spaces and make recommendations to proper authority for rehabilitation, renovation, alteration, modification, and new construction as required.

12. Exercise effective control over the financial operations within the command through applying sound accounting principles; progressively modernizing programming, budgeting, accounting, and statistical reporting under the Resource Management System. Prepare vulnerability assessments and management control reviews, conduct internal reviews using Standards for Audit of Government Organizations, Programs, Activities, and Functions issued by the Comptroller General of the United States.

13. Exercise control over numerous management programs and functional areas inherent of a naval shore activity which should include, but not be limited to, retention, 3-M, occupational safety and health, traffic and recreational safety, internal review, equal employment opportunity, command managed equal opportunity, and other similar management programs.

14. Maintain liaison with other elements of the TRIDENT system including ships, refit facility, and Fleet staffs to ensure a continuous exchange of information to support changes and/or improvements to training courses in order to be responsive to Fleet training requirements.

15. Maintain close liaison with the Local Planning Agent, or such other commander as may be designated in writing, for emergency and disaster preparedness matters.

16. Serve as the Dedicated Visual Information Support Activity (DVISA) for TRITRAFAC Bangor.

17. Keep CNET advised regarding the general progress and results of training being conducted in the command.

18. Perform such other functions as may be directed by CNET.
