(NAVSUBSCOL), GROTON, CT

Encl: (1) Functions of NAVSUBSCOL

1. Purpose. To publish functions of NAVSUBSCOL under the mission established by reference (a).

2. Cancellation. CNTECHTRAINST 5450.51D

3. Mission. To train officers and enlisted personnel in the basic knowledge and skills upon which operational submarine commands in the Atlantic and Pacific submarine forces can build competence and proficiency in operating and maintaining submarines and all their systems; to provide functional, refresher, advanced, and team training to submarine and submarine support personnel in order to increase and maintain knowledge and proficiency in specific skills; to furnish specific operationally oriented support to submarines to ensure maximum effectiveness of their sensor systems; and to perform such other training and sensor support functions as may be directed by competent authority.

4. Status and Command Relationships. NAVSUBSCOL is a shore activity in an active, fully operational status.

- (2) Chief of Naval Education and Training (CNET)

b. Area Coordination

- (1) Area Coordinator - Commander in Chief, U.S. Atlantic Fleet
- (2) Regional Area Coordinator - Commander, Submarine Group Two

5. Overseas Diplomacy. NAVSUBSCOL serves as an effective instrument of the U.S. foreign policy by initiating and

conducting action programs which promote positive relations between the command and foreign nationals, and which assist individual naval personnel and their families to work effectively, live with dignity and satisfaction, and function as positive representatives of the Navy and of the United States while overseas.

6. Action. In accomplishing the assigned mission, NAVSUBSCOL will ensure performance of the functions in enclosure (1) and advise CNET of any recommended modification to the mission or functions of NAVSUBSCOL.

FUNCTIONS OF NAVSUBSCOL

1. Carry out all regulations and directives from higher authority pertaining to the administration of NAVSUBSCOL; issue such detailed internal directives and regulations as are required for the efficient organization and administration of the command.
2. Ensure that training courses developed or revised by the command are in consonance with the instructional systems development procedures established by higher authority; ensure that the training of all personnel enrolled in the schools and courses established by CNET, at this command, is conducted in accordance with directives and procedures established by higher authority.
3. In support of Navy policy emphasizing the importance of military and motivational training and in recognition of the effect such training has on retention, upgrading professionalism, and improving the perception of the Navy, ensure that the military and motivational aspects of training are given strong emphasis equal to the emphasis afforded the technical areas.
4. Ensure successful and uniform accomplishment of training in accordance with prescribed course material on a standardized basis. Evaluate instruction and the complete training situation on a continuing basis.
5. Make recommendations to CNET regarding the need for development of new course material and any necessary changes to established curricula.
6. Provide facilities and instruction for submarine refresher training, maintenance training, and conduct basic and advanced operational and tactical training for submarine personnel.
7. Conduct pre-acceptance and periodic review of contractor prepared curricula and other training material when directed by higher authority.
8. Review standards of qualifications in submarines for both officer and enlisted personnel as directed by higher authority.
9. Participate in programs to standardize submarine training including fulfilling all requirements as the lead school for selected curricula in accordance with directions from higher authority.
10. As directed, conduct Submarine Type Commander and CNO controlled courses of instruction.

11. Provide facilities for the operational support necessary to ensure maximum effectiveness of specified SSN's (Nuclear Attack Submarines) and sensor systems (acoustic, electromagnetic, visual, electro-optical, and photographic) in support of the Submarine Surveillance Equipment Program.
12. Provide existing courses, or specially tailored adaptations thereof, as directed by CNET to meet the training requirements of the Navy and, to the degree necessary, the Marine Corps, Army, Air Force, Coast Guard, foreign nationals under the International Military Education Training (IMET) Program or Foreign Military Sales (FMS), and civilian personnel attached to Navy industrial activities.
13. Exercise effective control over the financial operations within the command through sound accounting principles and progressive modernization of programming, budgeting, accounting, and statistical reporting and auditing practices under the Resources Management System of the Department of the Navy.
14. Exercise control over numerous management programs and functional areas inherent of a naval shore activity which should include, but not be limited to, retention, 3-M, occupational safety and health, traffic and recreational safety, internal review, equal employment opportunity, command managed equal opportunity, and other similar management programs.
15. Maintain close liaison with the Regional Area Coordinator, or such other commander as may be designated in writing, for emergency and disaster preparedness matters.
16. Serve as a Dedicated Visual Information Support Activity (DVISA) for NAVSUBSCOL.
17. Keep CNET advised regarding the general progress and results of training being conducted in the command.
18. Perform such other functions as may be directed by CNET.
