1. Purpose. To publish functions of NAVNUWRTRAU Ballston Spa under the mission established by reference (a).

3. Mission. To provide training to Navy personnel in the operation and maintenance of nuclear power plants and to furnish personnel to operate the land prototype reactor.

FUNCTIONS OF NAVNUPWRTRAU BALLSTON SPA

1. Carry out all regulations and directives from higher authority pertaining to the administration of NAVNUPWRTRAU Ballston Spa and issue such detailed internal directives as are required for the efficient organization and administration of the command.
2. Train, qualify, and designate operators for naval nuclear propulsion plants.
3. Provide operational maintenance training in nuclear propulsion plants.
4. Provide training in reactor water chemistry and designate personnel satisfactorily completing training as Engineering Laboratory Technicians.
5. Provide qualified operators for land based naval nuclear propulsion plants under the technical supervision and operational authority of the Department of Energy.
6. Administer personnel assigned to NAVNUPWRTRAU Ballston Spa.
7. Exercise effective control over the financial operations within the Command through sound accounting principles and progressive modernization of programming, budgeting, accounting progress, and statistical reporting and auditing practices under the Resource Management System of the Department of the Navy.
8. Exercise control over numerous management programs and functional areas inherent of a naval shore activity which should include but not limited to, retention, 3-M, occupational safety and health, traffic and recreational safety, internal review, equal employment opportunity, command managed equal opportunity, and other similar management programs.
9. Perform such other functions as may be directed by CNET and as coordinated with the Nuclear Program Manager (PERS-24).
