Subj: EDUCATOR ORIENTATION VISITS (EOV)

1. Purpose. To establish policies and procedures, and delineate responsibilities of Naval Education and Training Command (NAVEDTRACOM) activities conducting subject visits in support of Navy Recruiting Command.

2. Cancellation. CNETINST 5720.3D

3. Background. Educator Orientation Visits are jointly sponsored by the Chief of Naval Education and Training (CNET) and the Commander, Navy Recruiting Command (COMNAVCRUITCOM) to increase awareness among civilian high school and university and college educators, administrators, and counselors about professional training methods and excellent educational opportunities available to men and women entering naval service. Selected visitors, escorted by COMNAVCRUITCOM personnel, visit various NAVEDTRACOM activities to learn about Navy training. Visits include briefings and meetings with Navy officials, and familiarization visits to classroom sites, berthing, messing, recreation facilities, and other facilities as appropriate.

4. General Policies and Responsibilities

a. COMNAVCRUITCOM. Provide NAVEDTRACOM activities, where applicable, a listing of desired visit sites and proposed dates. (R)

b. NAVEDTRACOM Site Commanders. Determine feasibility of proposed itinerary and notify COMNAVCRUITCOM of their recommendations. (R)

c. Commanders of Selected Sites. Liaison directly with recruiting districts for coordination purposes.
