
Subj: OVERSIGHT RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE FEDERAL MAGISTRATES PROGRAM

Ref: (a) SECNAVINST 5822.1A
(b) COMNAVLEGSVCCOMINST 5800.1D

1. Purpose. To designate oversight responsibility for the Federal Magistrates Program within the Chief of Naval Education and Training (CNET) area of responsibility (AOR) to the CNET Force Judge Advocate (FJA).

2. Background. Reference (a) encourages the use of magistrates on naval installations to the maximum extent practicable. Reference (b) assigns responsibility for oversight of the Federal Magistrates Program to the command services officer at the local Trial Service Office, except where the area coordinator has assigned it to another activity. Oversight responsibility includes liaison with the U.S. Attorney, Naval Criminal Investigative Service (NAVCRIMINSERV), Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI), and base security force. CNET is the area coordinator for all naval facilities in the Pensacola and Panama City Divisions of the Northern District of Florida, the Southern District of Mississippi, and the Western District of Tennessee.

3. Action. All Judge Advocates serving as Special Assistant United States Attorneys within CNET's AOR will report directly to the CNET FJA. The CNET FJA will liaison with U.S. Attorneys, base security forces, NAVCRIMINSERV, and the FBI.
