1. Purpose. To promulgate the uniform outfitting lists for personnel in the NROTC Program.
2. Cancellation. CNETINST 1020.4P
3. Information. Reference (a) prescribes the occasions for which the uniform shall be worn, its composition and description of uniform clothing.
4. Action. Enclosure (1) provides specific uniform guidance. Enclosures (2) through (5) are the lists to be used for outfitting midshipmen.

MIDSHIPMEN UNIFORM GUIDANCE

(A)

1. GENERAL. The items listed in enclosures (2) through (5) are required uniforms, quantities, and time frames to issue midshipmen uniforms. All items contained in the initial issue display may be issued at one time, or may be issued at a later time depending on unit needs.

a. The cruise issues should emulate the summer training uniform requirements listed in the Midshipman Summer Training Manual (NAVEDTRA 37300). The manual can be found on CNET web site. Ensure that the midshipmen have the appropriate items and the quantities needed for cruise requirements. If a midshipman reports to his/her summer training site without the proper uniforms, he/she will be required to purchase that uniform with out-of-pocket funds. The uniforms listed for cruise requirements don't necessarily mean that you will issue more uniforms; it simply means that the midshipmen should have that uniform item in their seabag.

b. Specific local requirements or deviations shall only be done with prior approval from CNET (OTE411).

c. All footwear, shoes and boots, will be kept by the midshipman and not turned in unless the midshipman is dropped from the program. Units that are still in possession of khaki and black windbreakers will continue issuing until exhausted.

2. ECP/BOOST/NECP/MECEP UNIFORMS

a. BOOST Uniform Requirements - BOOST graduates are NROTC scholarship midshipmen, and are to be issued the same uniforms as scholarship midshipmen. BOOST graduate uniforms are issued at BOOST and they will not have any requirements from the NROTC Unit.

b. ECP Uniform Requirements - ECPs are given a uniform allowance at the Naval Science Institute in Newport prior to reporting to NROTC units. With that allowance they are expected to provide all uniforms needed. They have no requirements from the NROTC Unit.

c. NECP Uniform Requirements - NECPs are given a uniform allowance after they get to the unit, fill out the proper form, and send the form to their servicing PSD. With that allowance they are expected to provide all uniforms needed. They have no uniform requirements from the NROTC Unit.

d. MECEP Uniform Requirements - MECEP wears their enlisted uniforms and have no uniform requirements from the NROTC Unit.

3. COMMUTATION. It is DOD policy to provide commutation funds instead of uniforms for members of the NROTC program at the following military units: The Citadel, Maine Maritime Academy, Norwich University, SUNY, Texas A&M University, VMI, and VPI. **The Navy's initial issue uniforms will not be issued to midshipmen at these units; only summer training uniforms will be issued.**

4. DRESS WHITE UNIFORM. The service dress white and the choker white uniform are graduation issue, but may be issued earlier if a unit desires. Keep in mind that there will be one dress white/choker uniform issued to each midshipman. If a unit decides to issue the uniform before the graduation issue, the midshipman will be responsible for any future replacements, repairs, or tailoring.

5. The following changes have been made to the uniform requirements:

a. Most all NSNs and prices have changed.

b. Coveralls have been added for 2nd and 1st class cruises.

c. The following uniform items have been deleted: white dress gloves, black necktie, p/w black shirt, p/w blue trouser, tie clasp, black handbag, white handbag, belted white skirt, black pumps.

d. The following uniform items have been added: Navy PT shorts and shirts, Navy sweatpants and shirt, Marine Corps PT shorts and shirts, Marine Corps sweatpants and shirt.

e. The following uniform items have been replaced: brown undershirt replaced with green undershirt, combat boot replaced with infantry boot.
